Dayton Man Sentenced to 36 Months in Prison for Drug Related Offenses

Joshua L. Young, 26, of Dayton, Ohio, appeared on April 16, 2014, for the purpose of a pretrial hearing. Young entered a change of plea to guilty for an indictment charging one (1) count of Illegal Assembly or Possession Of Chemicals for the Manufacture of Drugs, a felony of the third degree, and one (1) count of Possession of Cocaine, a felony of the fifth degree.

The Court sentenced Young to a total of thirty-six (36) months in the State Penal System which shall be served consecutively to the prison term that he is currently serving out of Montgomery County, also for drug related offenses. Young was ordered to pay a \$5,000.00 mandatory fine and was given a four (4) year driver's license suspension.

Prosecutor Blackburn reports that "On January 23, 2012, Young was found to be in possession of items commonly used to manufacture methamphetamine as well as cocaine."

This case was investigated by the Athens County Sheriff's Office.
