ATHENS, OHIO—November 20, 2013

Kimari Anderson, age 35, of Charlotte, North Carolina appeared before Judge L. Alan Goldsberry on November 20, 2013 and entered a not guilty plea to one (1) count of Trafficking in Cocaine, a first degree felony and one (1) count of Possession of Cocaine, also a first degree felony, both have a Major Drug Offender Specification. Judge L. Alan Goldsberry set bond at \$60,000 with 10 percent allowed. Anderson has to stay in Ohio during the pendency of this case. A jury trial has been set for January 7, 2014

Prosecutor Blackburn says, “On November 7, 2013 the Ohio State Highway Patrol did a routine traffic stop and stopped Kimari Anderson of Charlotte, North Carolina. After doing a search of Anderson’s car she is accused of being in possession of 198 grams of Cocaine.”

This case was investigated by the Ohio State Highway Patrol.
