Athens County Prosecutor Keller Blackburn reports that on October 11, 2013, Austin Daugherty, age 22, of Greasy Ridge Road, Logan, Ohio appeared before Judge L. Alan Goldsberry and was sentenced to four (4) years in prison.

Prosecutor Blackburn reports that “on October 11, 2013, Austin Daugherty was sentenced to four (4) years in prison for one (1) Felony count of Breaking and Entering, two (2) Felony counts of Burglary, two (2) counts of Grand Theft when the property is a Firearm.”

In June of 2013, Daugherty broke the glass door of the Mountaineer Mechanical business, entered and stole multiple firearms.

On October 11, 2013, Daugherty was also sentenced to six (6) months in prison on another Felony charge of Breaking and Entering, which will be served concurrent to the prior sentence.

In July of 2012 Daugherty broke the front door of the Mountaineer Mechanical business and into a work van that was on the premises.

Daugherty will be serving a total aggregate of four (4) years for all Felony Charges and they will run concurrent. The State of Ohio will not oppose Judicial Release after 6 months in prison pending a favorable report from the warden. If Judicial Release is granted the defendant will be required to complete a community based correction based facility program like the SEPTA in Nelsonville.”

Both cases were investigated by the Athens County Sheriff’s Department.
