Two Athens County Men Have Time Added to Prison Stay

Zachariah Dye, age 36, from The Plains, Ohio appeared before Judge George P. McCarthy on November 8, 2013 and was sentenced to one (1) year in prison for one (1) count of Receiving Stolen Property, a fifth degree Felony and three (3) counts of Forgery which are also fifth degree Felonies. Prosecutor Keller Blackburn says, "Dye pled guilty and was sentenced to one year in prison." This case was investigated by the Athens City Police Department.

Joshua Wooten, age 32, from Chauncey, Ohio appeared before Judge L. Alan Goldsberry on November 8, 2013 and was sentenced to six (6) months in prison consecutive to his current Athens County term for one (1) count of Menacing by Stalking, a fourth degree Felony. Prosecutor Keller Blackburn says, "Wooten pled guilty and was sentenced to an additional 6 months in prison." This case was investigated by the Athens County Sheriff's Office.
