Ian Stevers Will Spend Five (5) Years in Prison

ATHENS, OHIO—November 22, 2013— Athens County Prosecuting Attorney Keller Blackburn today announced that Ian Stevers will spend five (5) years in prison.

Ian Stevers, age 28, of Pomeroy, Ohio appeared before George P. McCarthy on November 20, 2013 and pled guilty to one (1) count of Possession of Heroin, a fifth degree felony. Judge McCarthy sentenced him to twelve (12) months in prison on that case, consecutive to four (4) years in prison for violating the terms of his Community Control on prior charges.

Prosecutor Blackburn says, “Stevens was on Community Control for prior drug related convictions. He violated his Community Control and the Court ordered that Stevens serve a five (5) year prison term.”

These cases were investigated by the Athens County Sheriff Office and the Nelsonville Police Department.
