FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE Jacob Stump is Sentenced to Prison for Two Years

ATHENS, OHIO—December 13, 2013— Athens County Prosecuting Attorney Keller Blackburn announced today that Jacob Stump was sentenced to two (2) years in prison.

Jacob Stump, age 32, of Nelsonville, Ohio appeared before Judge L. Alan Goldsberry on Thursday, December 12, 2013 and entered a guilty plea to two (2) felony counts:

- 1. One (1) count of Illegal Assembly or Possession of Chemicals for the Manufacture of Drugs, a third degree felony.
- 2. One (1) count of Aggravated Possession of Drugs, a fifth degree felony.

Judge L. Alan Goldsberry sentenced Jacob Stump to two (2) years in prison with no opportunity for judicial release.

Athens County Prosecutor Keller Blackburn says, "Methamphetamine is a highly potent and addictive drug and destroys the user's life. My office works daily to get manufacturers off the streets of Athens County and the State."
