Patrick Magee Gets Four Years in Prison

ATHENS, OHIO—December 10, 2013— Athens County Prosecuting Attorney Keller Blackburn announced today that Patrick Magee will spend four (4) years in prison with no opportunity for judicial release.

Patrick Magee, age 39, of Nelsonville, Ohio appeared before Judge L. Alan Goldsberry and was sentenced to four (4) years in prison with no opportunity for judicial release. Magee was convicted of one (1) count of Aggravated Vehicular Assault, and one (1) count of Tampering with Evidence, both third degree felonies and one (1) count of Vandalism, a fourth degree felony.

Prosecutor Blackburn says, “Patrick Magee will spend four (4) years in prison with no opportunity for judicial release. A Nelsonville police officer attempted to stop Magee for numerous traffic violations, he failed to stop and a high-speed chase ensued. The chase ended with Magee crashing his car into the residence of Rosella and John Brown and causing substantial damage to their home.”

This case was investigated by the Nelsonville Police Department.
