Athens County Prosecutor Keller Blackburn reports that on October 22, 2013, Ryan Koon, age 23, appeared before Judge George P. McCarthy and was sentenced to the remainder of his four (4) years and eleven (11) months in prison.

Prosecutor Blackburn reports that “on October 22, 2013, Ryan Koon’s Judicial Release was terminated and he was sentenced to the remainder of his four (4) years and eleven (11) months in prison with credit for time already served. In August of 2013 Koon entered a plea of guilty in 10CR0038 to two (2) counts of Burglary, both felonies of the third degree, and one (1) count of Grand Theft, a felony of the third degree, and in 10CR0409 to two (2) counts of Breaking and Entering, both felonies of the fifth degree.

The State filed a Supplemental Notice of Violation of Judicial Release on September 25, 2013, alleging that Koon has been charged with misdemeanors in Athens County Municipal Court for one (1) count of Theft, one (1) count of Possession of Marijuana, one (1) count of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, one (1) count of Possession of Criminal Tools, one (1) count of Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor, one (1) count of Receiving Stolen Property, and (1) count of Assault.

By committing those crimes Koon violated his Judicial Release and was sentenced to serve his remaining prison term for two (2) Counts of Burglary and one (1) count of Grand Theft in 10CR00038, and two (2) counts of Breaking and Entering in 10CR0409, which were committed in 2010. ”

Koon will have to pay restitution and court costs upon his release.
