Chauncey Man to Serve Prison Time for Trafficking in Heroin, Community Control Violations

William R. Goins, Jr., 43, of Chauncey, Ohio, appeared on February 6, 2014. Goins entered a change of plea of guilty to an indictment charging two (2) counts of Trafficking in Heroin, both felonies of the fourth degree in case number 13CR0471. Goins previously admitted to violating the terms and conditions of his community control in case numbers 10CR0390, 10CR0255 and 12CR0326.

Goins was sentenced to a total prison term of four (4) years and eleven (11) months for his community control violations and eighteen (18) months for his '13 case, to be served consecutively to one another.

Prosecutor Blackburn reports that "on August 7, 2013 and August 13, 2013, Goins did sell Heroin to a confidential informant, both times in the vicinity of juvenile. Goins' violations stem from the '13 case as well as admitting to his supervising officer that he used Heroin, was associating with an individual against the orders of the Adult Parole Authority, and provided false information to the Athens County Sheriff's Office, all in November of 2013."

The '13 case was investigated by the Athens County Narcotics Enforcement Team.
