ATHENS MAN GETS PRISON SENTENCE FOR DISRUPTING PUBIC SERVICES:

Man deters girlfriend from calling 911 after domestic dispute

Trevor A. Lee, 21, of Athens, Ohio, appeared in Court on February 12, 2014, for the purpose of sentencing. Lee previously entered a change of plea of guilty to an amended indictment charging one (1) count of Burglary, a felony of the third degree; one (1) count of Disrupting Public Services, a felony of the fourth degree; and one (1) count of Assault, a misdemeanor of the first degree.

Lee was sentenced to eighteen (18) months in the State Penal System for Disrupting Public Services. Lee will also serve five (5) years of community control upon his release from incarceration for the Burglary and Assault charges.

Prosecutor Blackburn reports that “on September 8, 2013, Lee did enter a residence on Carriage Hill in Athens, Ohio, broke the resident’s cell phone so that she could not call for help and pushed her up against a wall.”

This case was investigated by the Athens City Police Department.
