Reynoldsburg Man Sentenced to a Mandatory Three Year Prison Term for Possessing Oxycodone

Jawan M. White, 24, of Reynoldsburg, Ohio, appeared before Judge L. Alan Goldsberry on November 18, 2014, for his jury trial. Prior to empaneling a jury, White entered a change of plea to guilty to an indictment charging one (1) count of Aggravated Possession of Drugs. On October 20, 2012, subsequent to a traffic stop, White was found to be in possession of one hundred and seventy-one (171) Oxycodone pills of various milligrams.

Prosecutor Blackburn states that "The Court sentenced White to a three (3) year mandatory prison term. Upon his release from prison, White will be on three (3) years of mandatory post release control and will be subject to a six month driver's license suspension."

This case was investigated by the Athens County Sheriff's Office.
