***Reynoldsburg Man Sentenced to a Mandatory Three Year Prison Term
for Possessing Oxycodone***

Jawan M. White, 24, of Reynoldsburg, Ohio, appeared before Judge L. Alan Goldsberry on November 18, 2014, for his jury trial. Prior to empaneling a jury, White entered a change of plea to guilty to an indictment charging one (1) count of Aggravated Possession of Drugs. On October 20, 2012, subsequent to a traffic stop, White was found to be in possession of one hundred and seventy-one (171) Oxycodone pills of various milligrams.

Prosecutor Blackburn states that “The Court sentenced White to a three (3) year mandatory prison term. Upon his release from prison, White will be on three (3) years of mandatory post release control and will be subject to a six month driver’s license suspension.”

This case was investigated by the Athens County Sheriff's Office.
