Glouster Man Sentenced to Prison for Drug Possession

Michael J. Malcolm, 34, of Glouster, Ohio, appeared before Judge L. Alan Goldsberry on December 8, 2014, a hearing on community control violations and a pretrial. Malcolm previously stipulated to violating the terms of his community control in case number 12CR0023. On this date, Malcolm entered a change of plea to an indictment charging Aggravated Possession of Drugs in case number 14CR0368 for an incident that occurred in June of 2014, in which he was found to be in possession of Oxycodone pills, a schedule II controlled substance, that were not prescribed to him.

Prosecutor Blackburn states that “After the State and Defense argued sentencing, the Court sentenced Malcolm to a seven (7) month prison term in the 14 case and continued Malcolm on community control upon his release on the 12 case. Additionally, upon his release from prison, Malcolm will be on three (3) years of mandatory post release control and will be subject to a six month driver’s license suspension.”

The 14 case was investigated by the Athens County Sheriff’s Office.
