New Marshfield Man Sentenced to Prison for Theft and Possessing Criminal Tools

Jonathan L. Westerviller, 29, of Chauncey, Ohio, appeared before Judge George P. McCarthy on December 10, 2014, for pretrial hearings. On this date, Westerviller entered changes of pleas to two indictments, in case number 14CR0093 to one (1) count of Theft and one (1) count of Possessing Criminal Tools, both fifth degree felonies, and in case number 14CR0446 to one (1) count of Receiving Stolen Property, a fifth degree felony. Westerviller did take tires and rims from a vehicle parked at the park and ride on State Route 550 in Athens in December of 2013. Westerviller was also found to be in possession of a stolen go cart in July of 2014.

Prosecutor Blackburn states that “The Court sentenced Westerviller to a total term of (10) months in the State Penal System for case number 14CR0093. Upon his release from prison, Westerviller will begin a term of five years of community control in case number 14CR0446. Additionally, upon his release from prison, Malcolm will be subject to an optional term of three (3) years of mandatory post release control.”

Both cases were investigated by the Athens County Sheriff's Office.
