Joint Effort Results in the Arrests of Four Individuals

On January 5, 2015, law enforcement officers from the Athens County Prosecutor's Office, Athens County Sheriff's Office, Nelsonville Police Department and the Adult Parole Authority served a total of four (4) outstanding warrants.

Alice Allbaugh, 43, was arrested in Nelsonville on a warrant out of the Athens County Common Pleas Court. Allbaugh violated the terms and conditions of her community control and had been whereabouts unknown since February of 2014. Allbaugh will appear in Court on January 6, 2015.

Brittany Carrier, 28, was arrested in Buchtel on a holder by the Adult Parole Authority. Carrier violated the terms and conditions of her community control by failing to report to her supervising officer since August of 2014, as well as failing to notify her supervising officer of a change in residency. Carrier appeared in Court on January 6, 2015 and was placed on a \$35,000.00, no 10% bond.

Charles Perkins, 35, was arrested in Buchtel on a warrant out of the Athens County Common Pleas Court. Perkins violated the terms and conditions of his community control by failing to attend Health Recovery Services as ordered by the Court, and being whereabouts unknown since March of 2014. Perkins is scheduled to appear in Court on January 7, 2015.

Michael Lowry, who was at the same residence as Alice Allbaugh, was arrested on a warrant out of Athens Municipal Court.
