Glouster Woman Sentenced to Ten Years in Prison

Christel Jennice, 38, of Glouster, Ohio, appeared before Judge George P. McCarthy and entered a change of plea to guilty to an indictment charging one (1) count of Aggravated Robbery, a felony of the first degree; two (2) counts of Aggravated Burglary, felonies of the first degree and one (1) count of Possessing Criminal Tools, a felony of the fifth degree.

Judge McCarthy sentenced Jennice to a total prison term of ten (10) years. Jennice will serve the entire ten (10) year term and has agreed to not apply for, or receive, any form of early release. Upon her release from incarceration, Jennice will be subject to five (5) years of post-release control.

Prosecutor Blackburn states that “Jennice entered Jewell’s Drive Thru in November of 2014, and used a hammer to break the glass protecting the clerk and demanded money from her.”

This case was investigated by the Glouster Police Department and the Athens County Prosecutor’s Office.
