Glouster Man Sentenced To Twelve Months Prison for Trafficking Heroin

Jeffrey W. Degarmore, 48, of Glouster, Ohio, appeared before Judge George P. McCarthy on March 9, 2015, for the purpose of sentencing. Degarmore previously entered a change of plea to guilty to an indictment charging three (3) counts of Trafficking in Heroin, all felonies of the fifth degree.

Judge McCarthy sentenced Degarmore to twelve (12) months in the State Penal System. Degarmore will not be eligible for early release. Upon his release from prison, Degarmore will be subject to an optional term of three (3) years of post-release control. Degarmore was ordered to undergo a six (6) month driver's license suspension and to pay Court costs.

Prosecutor Blackburn reports that "In 2014, on February 26th, March 4th and March 10th, Degarmore sold Heroin to a confidential informant."

This case was investigated by the Athens County Sheriff's Office.
