Jordan Alexander Dixon, 22, of Glouster, Ohio, appeared before Judge George P. McCarthy on April 13, 2015, for the purpose of sentencing. Dixon previously entered a change of plea to guilty on two indictments charging one count of Receiving Stolen Property, a misdemeanor of the first degree in case number 14CR0116 and one (1) count of Possession of Drugs, a felony of the fifth degree and two (2) counts of Possession of Heroin, felonies of the fifth degree in case number 14CR0491.

Sentencing in this matter was argued with the State asking for a three (3) year prison term to be served consecutively with the 2012 cases he is currently incarcerated for, and Defense asking for probation.

Judge McCarthy sentenced Dixon to a total prison term of one (1) year and five (5) months to be served consecutively to his 2012 cases.

These cases were investigated by the Athens County Sheriff's Office and the Glouster Police Department.
