Glen A. Skidmore, 31, of New Lexington, Ohio, appeared before Judge Patrick J. Lang on April 20, 2015, for the purpose of sentencing. Skidmore previously entered a change of plea to guilty to an indictment charging one (1) count of Burglary, a felony of the third degree.

Judge Lang sentenced Skidmore to three (3) years in the State Penal System. Upon his release from prison, Skidmore will be required to complete the SEPTA program and pay restitution. Skidmore will also be subject to three (3) years of optional post-release control.

Skidmore's co-defendant, Daniel N. Spears Jr. entered a change of plea to one (1) count of Burglary in February and is scheduled for sentencing on April 29, 2015. A second co-defendant, David Koon is scheduled for a pretrial on April 22, 2015, for an indictment charging one (1) count of Burglary.

This case was investigated by the Glouster Police Department.
