Brian Keith Swart, 46, currently incarcerated in the Noble Correctional Institution for a Washington County conviction, appeared before Judge George P. McCarthy on May 21, 2015, for the purpose of a change of plea hearing. Swart entered a change of plea to guilty to an indictment charging one (1) count of Operating a Vehicle Under the Influence of Alcohol, a Drug of Abuse or a Combination of Them, a felony of the third degree, and one (1) count of Driving Under Suspension or in Violation of License Restriction, a misdemeanor of the first degree.

Judge George P. McCarthy sentenced Swart to serve a total of twenty-five (25) months in the State Penal System. Swart will be subject to a ten (10) year driver's license suspension and drug and alcohol counseling upon his release from prison.

This case was investigated by the Nelsonville Police Department.
