The Court revoked the underlying prison terms of the following individuals for violating the terms and conditions of their supervision:

Scott Berry, 42, of Nelsonville, Ohio. Berry was previously convicted of Possession of Drugs and placed on community control. On May 29, 2015, the Court found probable cause that Berry did violate the terms and conditions of supervision and ordered that he serve eighteen (18) months in the State Penal System.

Kyle Arrington, 28, of Chauncey, Ohio. Arrington was previously convicted of Grand Theft and placed on community control. On June 4, 2015, the Court found probable cause that Arrington did violate the terms and conditions of supervision and imposed his underlying twelve (12) month prison term.

Kevin Decker, 32, confined in the Department of Corrections for a conviction out of Hocking County. Decker was previously convicted of Aggravated Possession of Drugs and placed on community control. On June 8, 2015, the Court found probable cause that Decker did violate the terms and conditions of supervision and ordered that he serve twelve (12) months in the State Penal System.

Justin Chesser, 32, of The Plains, Ohio. Chesser was previously convicted of Possession of Heroin and placed on community control. On June15, 2015, the Court found probable cause that Arrington did violate the terms and conditions of supervision and imposed his underlying twelve (12) month prison term.

Bradley Spencer, 28, Murray City, Ohio. Spencer was previously convicted of Receiving Stolen Property and placed on community control. On June 16, 2015, the Court found probable cause that Decker did violate the terms and conditions of supervision and ordered that he serve eighteen (18) months in the State Penal System.
