Tricia Queen, 34, of New Marshfield, Ohio, appeared before Judge George P. McCarthy on June 2, 2015, for the purpose of a pretrial and hearing on Community Control violations. Queen entered a change of plea to guilty in case number 15CR0151, to one (1) count of Possession of Drugs, a felony of the fifth degree. Queen also previously admitted and the Court found probable cause that she did violate the terms and conditions of Community Control. Queen was previously convicted in case number 14CR0020 of one (1) count of Theft, a felony of the fifth degree; and in case number 14CR0147 of one (1) count of Aggravated Possession of Drugs, a felony of the fifth degree.

Judge McCarthy sentenced Queen to a total prison term of thirty (30) months. Queen will not be eligible for early release. Upon her release from prison, Queen will be subject to three (3) years of optional post-release control.

Queen's 15CR0151 case was investigated by the Athens Police Department.
