Patricia Nichole Vore, 29, of Glouster, Ohio, appeared before Judge George P. McCarthy on August 10, 2015, for the purpose of sentencing. Vore previously entered a change of plea to guilty to an indictment charging one (1) count of Engaging in a Pattern of Corrupt Activity, a felony of the first degree; three (3) count of Trafficking in Heroin, felonies of the third degree; two (2) counts of Trafficking in Heroin, felonies of the fourth degree; two (2) counts of Trafficking in Heroin, felonies of the fifth degree; one (1) count of Possessing Criminal Tools, a felony of the fifth degree; one (1) count of Aggravated Trafficking in Drugs, a felony of the fourth degree; one (1) count of Possession of Heroin, a felony of the fourth degree and one (1) count of Possession of Cocaine, a felony of the second degree.

Judge McCarthy sentenced Vore to three (3) years in the State Penal System for Engaging in a Pattern of Corrupt Activity. Upon her release from prison, for all other charges, Vore will begin five (5) years of community control, with an underlying prison term of ten (10) years should she violate the terms and conditions of community control.

This case was investigated by the Athens County Prosecutor's Office, the Athens Major Crimes Unit, Hocking Major Crimes Unit, Glouster Police Department, Athens County 9-1-1, Perry County Sheriff's Office, Ohio State Highway Patrol and the Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI), Licking County Sheriff's Office, Adult Parole Authority.
