Guy Wolfenbarger, Jr., 41, of Columbus, Ohio, appeared before Judge Patrick J. Lang on July 31, 2015, for the purpose of a pretrial hearing. Wolfenbarger entered a change of plea to guilty to an indictment charging one (1) count of Robbery, a felony of the second degree; one (1) count of Robbery, a felony of the third degree and one (1) count of Possessing Criminal Tools, a felony of the fifth degree.

Judge Lang sentenced Wolfenbarger to four (4) years in the State Penal System. Wolfenbarger shall pay restitution to Certified Oil and will be subject to three (3) years of mandatory post-release control upon his release from incarceration.

Prosecutor Blackburn states that “Wolfenbarger did rob the Certified Gas Station in Glouster and did hold the cashier at gun point. It was later discovered that the gun was a toy.”

This case was investigated by the Athens County Prosecutor's Office and the Glouster Police Department.
