Jeremy Dye, Ohio, was indicted by the September Term of the Hocking County Grand Jury on December 18, 2015, for one (1) count of Unauthorized Use of the Ohio Law Enforcement Gateway, a felony of the fifth degree.

Prosecutor Blackburn reports that “On or about April 4, 2014, Dye is accused of disseminating an OHLEG report against rules and regulations of the Ohio Law Enforcement Gateway, while he was a deputy of the Hocking County Sheriff’s Office.”

Dye did appear before Judge John T. Wallace on this date and was released on his own recognizance.

This case was investigated by the Athens County Prosecutor’s Office. The Athens County Prosecutor has been appointed Special Prosecutor. Special Prosecutor Blackburn gave a limited grant of immunity to Hocking County Coroner David Cummin in exchange for cooperation and truthful testimony.
