ATHENS, Ohio – Eric Jordan Miller, 36, currently incarcerated in the Southeastern Ohio Regional Jail, was indicted by the January term of the Athens County Grand Jury on April 7, 2016, for Engaging in a Pattern of Corrupt Activity, Money Laundering, Possessing Criminal Tools and multiple Trafficking in Heroin charges.

Prosecutor Blackburn reports that, “Miller was arrested March 31, 2016, after an extensive investigation by the Athens County Prosecutor’s Office. As previously reported, Miller, also known as “E” has long been known to traffic drugs in our communities. With the assistance of the Columbus Police Department CRT Zone 3, the Meigs-Gallia County Task Force and the Fairfield-Hocking-Athens Major Crimes, Miller will answer for the allegations against him.”

Miller will be arraigned in the Athens County Court of Common Pleas on April 20, 2016.

Also indicted as part of this ring was Lindsey Roach, 24, of Meigs County, Ohio. Roach was indicted for Engaging in a Pattern of Corrupt Activity, Possessing Criminal Tools and multiple Trafficking in Heroin charges. Roach is wanted on a warrant at this time.
