ATHENS, Ohio – Kayla L. Long, 29, address unknown, appeared before Judge George P. McCarthy on July 11, 2016, for a hearing on community control violations. Long was convicted in June of two (2) counts of Conspiracy, felonies of the third degree and placed on five (5) years of community control. Long was provided an opportunity to obtain treatment and Vivitrol but continued to use drugs. Long was also sent to rehab and walked away from the program.

On Count One, Judge McCarthy imposed Long's underlying prison term of three (3) years in the State Penal System. Upon release from incarceration, Long will continue on community control on Count Two.

Long is part of an Engaging in a Pattern of Corrupt Activity case involving Michael Meadows, Cinthia Glover, Courtney Meadows and Patricia Eblin that was investigated by the Athens County Prosecutor's Office.
