ATHENS, Ohio – Michael D. Meadows, 39, of Millfield, Ohio, appeared before Judge Patrick J. Lang on July 14, 2016, for the purpose of sentencing. Meadows previously entered a plea of guilty to an indictment charging one (1) count of Engaging in a Pattern of Corrupt Activity, a felony of the first degree and two (2) counts of Conspiracy, felonies of the second degree.

Judge Lang sentenced Meadows to two (2) years in the State Penal System on the Engaging charge and five (5) years of community control on the remaining charges, to begin upon his release from prison.

Meadows is part of an Engaging in a Pattern of Corrupt Activity case involving Cinthia Glover, Courtney Meadows, Patricia Eblin and Kayla Long that was investigated by the Athens County Prosecutor's Office.
